One of our field staff asked me, “How do we implement Beyond’s emphasis on one another care?” Here’s an easy family game to help you implement these instructions from God’s heart. Each of the following texts are like “spiritual growth hormones.”

The Game: Each morning during breakfast, pick one of the following verses, and find at least one opportunity to implement it during that day. Then at dinnertime talk about your experiences. Make note of the date and your experiences you so you’ll remember.

Guarantee: The more you practice these, the more they’ll stick in your heart and naturally become how others see Christ in you.

Honor one another above yourselves (Rom. 12:10)		
Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud.... Do not be conceited. (Rom. 12:16)		
Be subject to one another (Eph. 5:21)		
Regard one another as more important than yourselves (Phil. 2:3)		
Clothe yourselves in humility toward one another (1 Pet. 5:5)		

Don't judge one another (Rom. 14:13)
